Mosaico began in 1991 as a group of concerned residents and business owners who helped to renovate a dilapidated, abandoned mill complex in Bristol and convert it into elderly housing and space for the Department of Youth Services.

In the past, Mosaico CDC has partnered with Rhode Island institutions of higher education including the International Yacht Restoration School (IYRS), New England Institute of Technology (NEIT) and MotoRing Technical Training Institute (MTTI) to ensure that participants receive the best training available in a field where jobs are currently available for skilled/qualified individuals.

## **Mosaico Today**

Today Mosaico has grown to serve more than the local neighborhood, having designed and implemented meaningful educational programs to support the Town of Bristol's businesses, schools, and citizens using funds provided through grants from local, national, business and community organizations.

## **Workforce Development Program**

Mosaico works with the unemployed and under employed residents of Bristol and Warren providing them with information on the marine, health care and green technology fields including:

- ❖ Types of employment opportunities
- ❖ Skills training programs available
- ❖ Employment opportunities as they become available
- ❖ Job search support

## **Job Training Grants**

To continue and expand its training partnerships, Mosaico CDC has training grants available for students who are interested in enrolling in marine, health care or green technology programs. Eligibility requirements for these grants include:

- ❖ Student's household income must fall within the low to moderate income limits (Income Limits Defined by FY 2010 HUD Metro FMR for Bristol, RI)
