

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE I,
§§ 18-8 & 18-9 OF THE WARREN TOWN CODE

The Town Council of the Town of Warren hereby ordains:

Chapter 18, Article I, § 18-8 is hereby amended as follows:

In subsection (a), the phrase “in the compact part of the town” is hereby deleted, and replaced with the phrase “in the Town of Warren”.

Said Chapter, Article and Section are hereby further amended by adding the following subsections:

(c) No owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall remove snow from the building or lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for to another lot of land without the permission of the person who owns, occupies or cares for that lot of land.

(d) No owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall remove snow from the building or lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for into a public sidewalk, public street or right-of-way so as to cause a hazard or obstruction, including sight obstruction, to vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

(e) The owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall be required to keep any and all fire hydrants located on or adjacent to the lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for clear of all snow and accessible to fire personnel at all times.

(f) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished in accordance with section 1-8 for each day after the expiration of such six (6) hours that the snow shall remain on the public sidewalk, public street or right-of-way.

Chapter 18, Article I, § 18-9 is hereby also amended as follows:

The current paragraph in this Section is hereby designated as Subsection (a), and the phrase “in the compact part of the town” in that paragraph is hereby deleted, and replaced with the phrase “in the Town of Warren”.

Said Chapter, Article and Section are hereby further amended by adding the following subsections:

(b) No owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall remove ice from the building or lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for to another lot of land without the permission of the person who owns, occupies or cares for that lot of land.

(c) No owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall remove ice from the building or lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for into a public sidewalk, public street or right-of-way so as to cause a hazard or obstruction, including sight obstruction, to vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

(d) The owner, occupant, or any other person having care of any building or lot of land shall be required to keep any and all fire hydrants located on or adjacent to the lot of land that they own, occupy or have care for clear of all ice and accessible to fire personnel at all times.

(e) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished in accordance with section 1-8 for each day after the expiration of such six (6) hours that the ice shall remain on such public sidewalk, public street or right-of-way.
