

Chapter 18 – STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, Article 1 – In General, Sec. 18-5 – Use of Sidewalks for Commercial Purposes.

- (A) Any person displaying merchandise for retail sales and displays said merchandise on any sidewalk is subject to the provisions of this section.
- (1) A merchant shall be allowed to display goods, wares and merchandise on the sidewalk in front of the retail store in the following manner.
- a. No more than fifty (50%) percent of the front of the store shall be used for display purposes;
 - b. The display area shall be no more than twenty-four (24) inches from the outside wall of the retail store;
 - c. The goods, wares, or merchandise in the display area shall not exceed a height of ~~four (4')~~ six (6') feet;
 - d. Any retail store located on or at an intersection of two (2) or more streets shall not display any goods, wares or merchandise in such a manner that will obstruct the vision of any operator of a motor vehicle or pedestrian on or approaching said intersection.
 - e. Regardless of any other conditions, a forty-eight (48) inch public right-of-way shall be maintained at all times on public sidewalks and thoroughfares.
 - f. The display merchandise on a sidewalk must remove items during such times as inclement weather such as a snow ban or high wind condition is present.
 - g. The Town Council may waive the provisions of this section during such times as commercial promotional events or public celebrations are to take place in an area
