Brush and yard waste is welcome at the Transfer Station.

The facility will be open 28 Saturdays throughout the year, so please confirm the day you are planning to go (see the calendar on the next page) or call 245-3910.

Vehicles entering the facility MUST stop on the scale until the Clerk signals them to proceed. The vehicle must stop at the office for inspection of the load. Any persons dumping material in a location other than the specified areas will lose the right to use the Transfer Station.



Computer monitors, televisions and electronic waste can be brought to the Transfer Station at no charge.






Rules and Regulations

Resident Sticker Policy

1. Residents with a sticker are allowed to dispose of 1000 pounds of trash annually, from July to July. Yard waste and metal are free of charge. The first overage will be manual charged. Once the limit is exceeded, commercial rates will apply to all.
2. By law, this facility cannot accept any hazardous waste. This includes, but is not limited to, paints, thinners, pesticides, gasoline or any product with CAUTION or WARNING on its label.
3. Loads will be sorted for proper disposal, i.e. trash, construction debris, metals, brush, yard waste, tires, televisions, computers, etc.
4. All wood will be no longer than 4 feet in length.
5. Attendant will inspect each load prior to dumping.
6. A fee will be charged for refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, mattresses and box springs.
7. Household hazardous waste can be disposed of by calling for an appointment with Rhode Island Resource Recovery Corporation at (401) 942-1430 ext. 241.
8. Waste oil, old oil filters, used antifreeze, televisions, computer monitors and all electronic waste may also be disposed in the designated areas free of charge to residents.
