POLICIES

- ❖ Residents with a sticker are allowed to dispose of 1,000 lbs. of trash yearly. Once the limit is exceeded, commercial rates will apply.
- ❖ No known commercial vehicles or dump trucks over 10,000 lbs. GVW can obtain a resident sticker.
- ❖ All vehicles entering the facility shall stop on the scale until the clerk signals them to proceed. All vehicles will then stop at the office for inspection of the load. Loads will be sorted for proper disposal.
- ❖ **An attendant will inspect each load prior to dumping.**
- ❖ By law, this facility cannot accept any hazardous waste; including but not limited to paints, thinners, pesticides, gasoline or any product with CAUTION or WARNING on its label.
- ❖ Household hazardous waste can be disposed of by calling for an appointment with RI Resource Recovery Corporation at (401) 942-1430 ext. 241.
- ❖ Waste oil, old oil filters and used antifreeze may be disposed of in designated areas free of charge to residents.
- ❖ All wood must be no longer than 4-feet in length.
- ❖ **Anyone dumping material in violation of these policies or in unapproved locations will lose the right to use the facility.**

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

As of August 1, 2016 electronic equipment can no longer be accepted at the Warren Transfer Station. All electronic equipment may be brought to the State-sponsored recycling center at the Barrington Public Works Department located at 84 Upland Way in the Town of Barrington.
